Academic renewal will be granted at the beginning of the semester the student will graduate from ISU. Students must have demonstrated satisfactory academic performance as evidenced by earning a GPA of at least 2.00 for all credits taken after returning to the university, with a minimum of 12.0 credit hours required.
