<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current policy is unwritten – proposal to document policy: • Mandatory class meetings outside of the regularly scheduled time must meet the following guidelines: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Any out-of-class meetings must be listed in the Schedule of Classes when the students register (2) Regular class time must be reduced for any scheduled out-of-class required meetings (3) Any required out-of-class examinations (e.g. night exams) must be approved by the Provost • Do we need to include anything related to exams taken outside of the class at the ISU Test Center?
