Update on Approved Policies <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Out of Term Schedule Change Policy – FS-EB – second reading 10/11/23 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Policy has been approved and is moving through final signatures</i> 	Terri Boylston
Grading Policy <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Currently, students can repeat up to 18 credits of courses and we record only the most recent take (colleges can award extra repeats to students); only grades earned at ISU factor into student's cumulative GPA; courses taken at institutions other than ISU can replace courses taken at ISU but grades earned elsewhere will not factor into cumulative GPA</i> <i>Workday will reflect all takes of a course and all grades at all institutions</i> <i>Discussion focused on language in this policy</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Admissions recruits TR students who want to increase their GPAs and we encourage them to repeat courses at current institution before coming here; TR students could exhaust all designated repeat credits before they even get here</i> <i>Financial aid implication: coming into compliance with change in Workday; students can receive financial aid for up to 2 takes of a course with a passing grade</i> <i>Terri to update language in policy to reflect changes discussed and put in CyBox; will discuss further and possibly vote on changes at next meeting</i>
