 "Appeals" is mentioned often in the current policy. Consensus is it should be changed to early reinstatement in most places.

 The majority of the meeting was spent discussing Reinstatement. Reinstatements will remain with college committees. Reinstatement criteria should be the same for all colleges. Information on appeals/early reinstatement process should be housed in one location (Office of Registrar?). #1 - Approved with following changes: Students should submit their petition for reinstatement to the College they wish to enter (rather than to the dean's office in the college they wish to enter for instructions specific to that college). Agreed #5 should be inserted into #1 as paragraph #2. 	

- Further discussion and change needed for last sentence regarding reinstatement into LAS.
- #2 Need to include a statement in the policy for students who didn't sit out.
- $#3 Keep \ as \ is.$
- #4 Approved with following additions:
 - Need to create condition rule within business process including academic unit student was in when dismissed and include Associate Dean from original college to determine whether student is permitted to be reinstated.
 - Need to create rule for students with 2+ majors if academically dismissed, they are dismissed from the university.
 - Determine if students who wish to re-enter a college with specific requirements must meet those requirements.
- #6 Discussion items:
 - Should this be limited to only juniors and seniors if the university (not the colleges) are making final decisions?
 - Determine process for submitting Early Reinstatements.
- #7 Further discussion needed to proposed changes:
 - Modify "...must accept whatever additional requirements are stipulated" to say "...will follow an academic plan stipulated"
 - Discuss with colleges whether we need to restrict GPAs and majors.
- o Student Appeal
 - Need to define what "appeal" means.
 - How is appeal different from early reinstatement?
- Academic Standing

 - Review is policy too complex and confusing?
 - Do we agree with current policy regarding changing colleges after Period 3?
