Academic Progress/Academic Dismissal/Reinstatement <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Priority for Faculty Senate How to present proposed policy changes – as one comprehensive policy change or as separate components? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Agreed to address all pieces to make sure they align and combine into one policy, then advance them piece by piece</i> Academic Dismissal <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Dismissal should be uniform across the university</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>3 of 6 colleges were overriding dismissal decisions</i> <i>Per Samantha, the Ivy College of Business wants to continue to have the ability to save students; she will take this proposed change back to BUS before a vote</i> <i>Students have opportunity to request early reinstatement</i> <i>Discussed revising language for exceptions for graduating seniors:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>“Students who would otherwise be academically dismissed but have met all graduation requirements, would have the Academic Dismissal waived and be eligible for graduation.
