Approval of minutes for last meeting (4/20/22).

New business.

Minor in Spanish translation and interpretation. Zarecor commented that the "Languages and Cultures Program" (LCP) is not really a program, and that maybe it should be considered as such in the future?

Communication with the colleges.

Tom Brumm thinks that perhaps we should improve our communication about issues discussed in FSCC. Kimberly brought up as an example the idea of shared general education lists. How can we better advocate for ideas in the FSCC back to our constituent colleges? We had a long conversation about centralized gen. eds. leading to a clearer understanding that the colleges at ISU are distinct in their evaluations of what constitutes college-level general education requirements. No action was taken.

Discontinuation of Latin undergraduate and graduate minors.

Motion to approve by Hargrove, second by Fox, the vote was 6-0-0 in favor of discontinuation

Unfinished business.

Continued discussion of stand-alone credits for minors. Cris Schwartz and Mark Hargrove would like time to build consensus for support in COE and LAS, respectively, and will do more work in each college to figure out who is affected and how we want to deal with it. We will bring this up again next fall.
