5. New Business

- a. Policy Discussion: should the following be adopted? Courses that are not dual-listed or not cross-listed may not be taught together in the same location at the same time
 - i. Example of Design courses taught in large Armory spaces, and that there may be a unique story to each of these cases
 - ii. May be an artifact of not properly using the Dual Listing process, this potentially looks like it could be exploited as a workaround.
 - iii. Will follow up with courses in Colleges to ask about the rationale for scheduling multiple courses in the same room, same time.
- b. Discontinuation: Biophysics Major
 - i. Biophysics has evolved into other disciplines currently, making the enrollment in this major very small.
 - ii. Motion by Kerton to discontinue the Biophysics program, seconded by Basmajian.
 - iii. Motion passed 6-0-0
- c. Addition to majors/minors catalog language previously approved.
 - i. Boylston presented.
 - ii. Tiarks raised question about multiple degrees in Business.
 - iii. Questions over students who want to complete full coursework for two majors without double counting of general education electives, and would this prohibit returning students from getting a second degree if from the same college. Example is B.S. in Math, followed by student returning to earn B.S. in Psychology (both LAS majors).
 - iv. Discussion of majors that offer both degree types, B.S. and B.A., and differences in requirements
 - v. Motion by Schwartz to approve current version of policy, seconded by Nilakanta.
 - vi. Motion passed 6-0-0
- d. Process for approval of interdisciplinary course/catalog changes.
 - i. Brumm informed that FSCC will handle these programs
