a. Undergraduate minor in Applied Artificial Intelligence

Question/comment	Response
How will 490s be approved for inclusion in the minor?	Any additions to the list of approved courses must be approved by the program curriculum committee, as per the governance document.
Will the approved list of courses (those beyond the two required core courses) be expanded?	The program curriculum committee is expanding the list of courses. Perkins will provide an expanded list when the proposal is considered by the Academic Affairs Council.
Is there an undergraduate certificate as mentioned in the governance document?	Not currently – the language in the governance document is just a placeholder for the future.
General discussion of the governance document and how interdisciplinary programs will be managed in the future.	LAS is the managing college. All curriculum changes in the future will happen in LAS.
General discussion of degrees and courses are approved in Workday and how this program will be an exception to the current catalog “freeze.”

- a. The Vet College is changing all R-credit courses from R to 1 credit. June asked if approvals are required for this.
