1. Call to order (2:01 p.m.)

3. Approval of minutes from 3/7/24: Minutes approved 7-0-0
4. Unfinished business: None
 - a. B.S. in Game Design. Poplin presented the updated governance document that addressed the committee's concerns about the details of program governance: details on the membership of the program curriculum committee were specified, the program will be administered by the College of Design and students will belong to that college, and there is no admissions process other than that to become an Iowa State student.
Approved 7-0-0.
 - b. B.S. in Educational Studies. Boylston presented a revised proposal that included the results of communication with the other Regent's institutions.
Approved 7-0-0.
5. New business
 - a. Merger of the Food Science and Culinary Food Science undergraduate degree programs. There will be only one degree – Food Science – with two options. One of the options will be a Culinary Food Science emphasis.
 - i. There were no concerns expressed.
 - ii. It was noted that options do not appear on a student's transcript.
 - iii. There was some question whether this should be considered as a discontinuation of the Culinary Food Science degree and a catalog modification of the requirements for the Food Science degree. Gillen will confer with the Board of Regents to determine if this approach is more appropriate.
 - iv. Approve 7-0-0
 - b. Undergraduate Certificate in Risk Management and Insurance. Brown presented the proposal and answered questions. Approved 7-0-0.
