**ITS Report:**

Resolved

- Allocated funds transparency – Summary was provided on Oct 14. Additional information on service charges will be provided on October 28.
- Design FS was frustrated that the licenses take a long time to get the key - As soon as there is approval to spend, 'key' is available - we believe there won't be a problem now. Will be happy to hear more about specific issues
- Concern over grad students cost to use Top Hat - The top hat agreement for all students is as follows: (no differentiation from undergrad, grad). All pay the same. If only a few grad faculty are using it then we will have to tackle it from the faculty usage standpoint, not licensing.
  - A Top Hat Classroom license covers all courses that use Top Hat for the duration of the license period and is available in the following options:
    - Four-year license: \$63.00
    - One-year license: \$32.00
    - One-semester license: \$21.00

Unresolved questions from past meetings

- They are unclear on what is ITS's job vs local resources - We can try to address in coming meeting: Scheduled for Nov 11 meeting.

There are some proctoring tools that have been used, but none have been so successful as to be considered a 'solution'. The TTAC group had a discussion about Academic integrity recently and I just got a report and haven't completely reviewed it yet, but I'll get back to you soon! They are looking at a number of tools including, but not limited to, Proctorio: <https://proctorio.com/>. We are still evaluating!!
