

### **Elimination of the Committee on University Services**

Rationale for Removal of *The Committee on University Services*: Due to the elimination of the vice-president for university services position and the subsequent restructuring of the upper administration, the Committee on University Services is no longer in dialogue with the administration through this committee. The *Council on University Resource Policies and Allocations* has now assumed the responsibilities through the reallocated responsibilities with the corresponding vice presidents in the restructured administration. It is proposed by the Governance Council and the University Resource Policies and Allocations Council to update the Faculty Senate Bylaws to reflect this change. Therefore, the proposed change is to eliminate this committee as follows:

#### Article VI, Section 6. Council on University Resource Policies and Allocations

##### ~~3. Committee on University Services~~

- ~~a. Charge: The University Services Committee is charged to review the university infrastructure. Serves as the faculty advisory committee to the senior vice president for university services. Prepares reports and recommendations for the senate and for the senior vice president for university services.~~
- ~~b. Membership—Voting: One member from each college plus a chair.~~
- ~~c. Non-voting: Non-voting ex-officio member will be the vice president for university services.~~
- ~~d. Term of Office: Committee members will be appointed for a three-year term, renewable for a maximum of six years.~~
