Current Policy	Proposed Policy and Procedures
No more than 65 semester or 97 quarter credits earned at two-year colleges can be applied to a bachelor's degree from Iowa State University. While there is no limit to the number of credits that may be transferred from a four-year institution, the last 32 semester credits before receiving a degree from Iowa State University must be completed at Iowa State University.	No more than 65 semester or 97 quarter credits earned at two-year colleges can be applied to a bachelor's degree from Iowa State University. While there is no limit to the number of credits that may be transferred from a four-year institution, the last 32 semester credits before receiving a degree from Iowa State University must be completed at Iowa State University. Credits earned while students participated in an ISU Study Abroad or National Student Exchange program are exempt from this requirement.

Policy revision adds exemption from the 32 credit rule for students participating in an ISU Study Abroad or National Student Exchange program. Goal is to make it easier for students to participate in these programs during their last year of coursework.
