 - a. Biophysics BS Discontinuation

Significant change in focus since origination in 1960. Drifted from biomechanics (nerve and muscle cell function) to molecular movement at the atomic level. This aspect is better served by the newly approved Biochemistry major with Biophysics focus. Only a handful have graduated within the past 10 years

Three main concerns were voiced concerning the implementation of a WorkDay Course Waitlist. First, exceptions do occur; there needs to be room in the software for this including ready access to those that need it. Second is prioritization. Some students need a particular course to graduate; how are that and other factors prioritized? Last, data currently is collected from these lists and based upon this data, changes are made to numbers of sections and instructors. We need to retain access to that data. Terri will report back.
