<p>Registration Waitlisting Policy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Policy to include policy for registration waitlisting to be included in the catalog <p>❖ Shawna presented on the Registration Waitlisting Policy and whether or not to include this policy in Workday, with the 3 options being:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Waitlisting with auto initiation into seat 2. Waitlisting with student initiation into seat 3. Not implementing waitlisting into system <p>❖ ASAC approved option #2</p> <p>❖ Assumptions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Certain groups could be prioritized, but only very rarely (i.e. advisors could override and jump FR for SR) ➤ Will not be available where approval is always necessary ➤ Students would have a set period of time to opt in ➤ If multiple course sections, students could still be waitlisted for a certain section ➤ Students will receive notifications to take action and how to take action – if they don’t take action within 24 hours, they will roll to bottom of waitlist – must take separate action to remove themselves from waitlist <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Would like following options: yes, accept seat; no, don’t accept and remove from waitlist; keep me on waitlist ➤ Advisors will also see reminder prompts ➤ Students have till 5th day to be added to waitlist ➤ Will be very strict with security of waitisting <p>❖ Items to be clarified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Language to be used in message; should include timezone ➤ Policy should include second half semester sections, summer and winter terms, link to AY calendar ➤ Eligibility overrides (tokens) ➤ Link goes to REG website, which spells out policy <p>❖ Next Steps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Records Workstream to clean up policy, including suggestions above; may need to go with bulleted format ➤ Shawna to bring policy back to ASAC for vote at next meeting 	<p>Jennifer Suchan Terri Boylston Shawna Saad</p>
